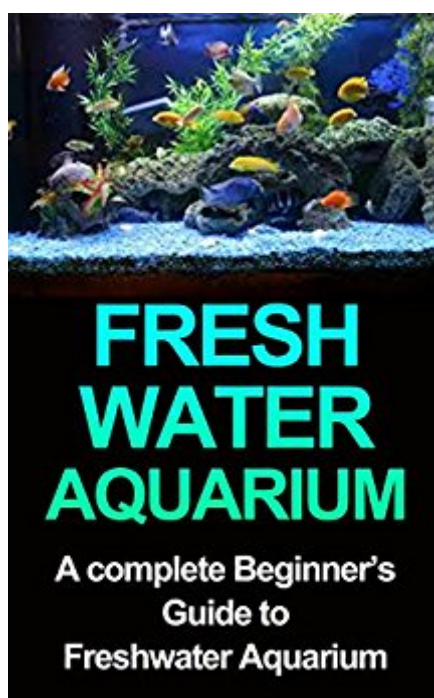

solved my problem. Acrylic tanks are lighter than glass tanks. This implies if you need to move an acrylic tank for diverse reasons; it will be much less demanding to do as such once the water has been removed than it will be for its glass partner. This additionally implies an acrylic tank will be less straining on the structure that is supporting it than a glass tank will.

If you are inexperienced with aquariums, you must purchase this book before you do anything!
