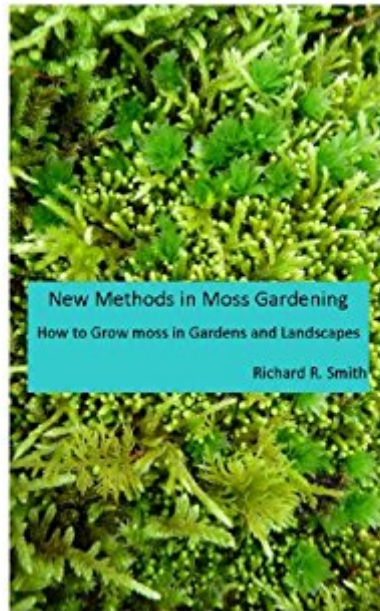

I am a beginning moss gardener, and I have gardened by trial and error. Most of my collecting is along paths, ditches, and woods. This book is connected to a website with an access code, but mine did not work. Despite that annoyance I found plenty of useful information; more is promised on website. Author puts penny in photos (not microscopic in detail), which is pretty helpful for me in identification. He addresses indoor and outdoor gardening, and he advises against terrarium

growing. Most useful part is his "moss mat" system of plastic, felt, and tulle netting. Language is for gardener, not botanist. Bibliography is good. This little book is worth buying, especially for Midwesterners. Thanks, Mr Smith. After I check out the website (if code works on non-Kindle device) I may upgrade.

Very informative and great illustrations. Personal experiences of the author give this text-book type book a very readable presentation. I enjoyed learning something new today.

No amount of googling can equate to this book. If you really want to learn more about moss, this is the book.
