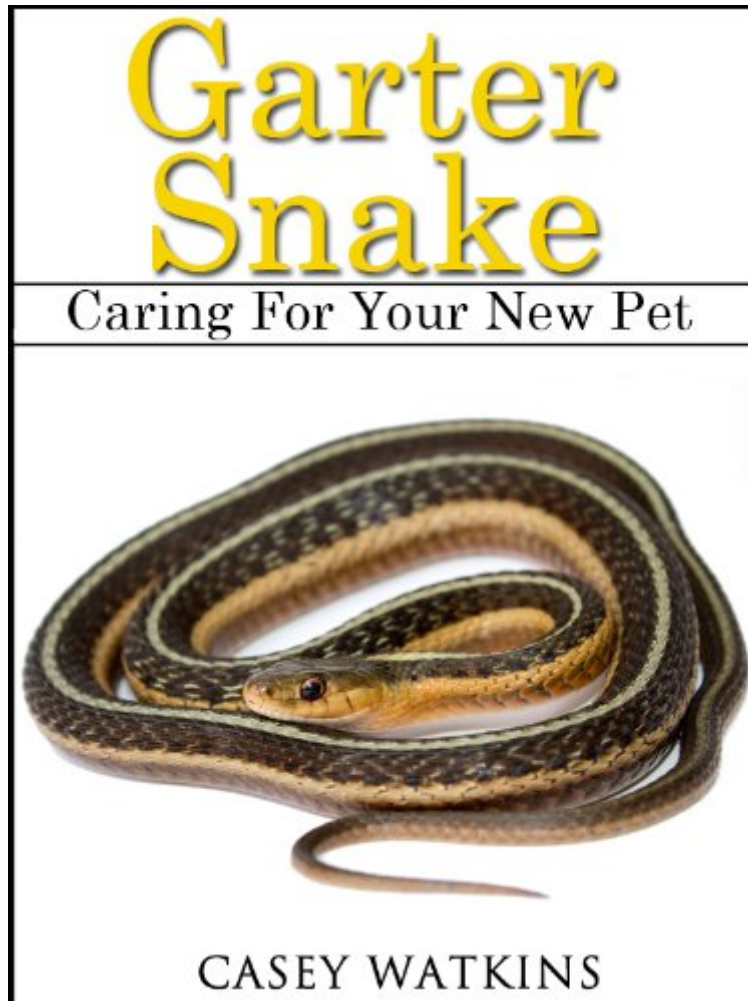

The author makes note that in the wild, garter snakes will literally eat any animal smaller than them which crosses their path. This makes it easy for any owner to give them the nutrition they require and there are several meal options the text suggests, including a breakdown of nutritional value for different fish, rodents, and insects that a garter will gladly chow on. Garters are bred in captivity by owners to produce new color combinations of snakes. This eBook contains valuable tips on breeding a snake should you be interested in increasing your collection size. The good news is that garter snakes are as prolific as rabbits and can have one or two litters per year, with a few dozen babies produced each time. Finally, the author touches on how to enjoy interacting with your garter snake. These animals are flighty by nature but can quickly become comfortable being held and stroked by humans. This eBook gives information on the process of acclimatizing a snake to your touch so that both handler and pet will become used to coming out of its enclosure and being handled or inspected.
